# LONDON ROLLING FILM FESTIVAL 2024: EXPANDED HORIZONS AND NEW HIGHLIGHTS

This year, the festival has doubled both the number of days and films shown, highlighting its significant growth and expanding influence in the film industry (325% increase in submissions from last year).

The London Rolling Film Festival will feature 13 awards judged by a distinguished panel of industry professionals. This year's jury includes **Paul McEvoy** (FrightFest), **Rachael Sutherland** (Palm Tree Universal) and President of the Jury **Amanny Mohamed** (Sky, BBC).

Among the awards is the "Kimberley Marren Recognition Award", sponsored by The Fan Carpet. This award honours the memory of the beloved actress and model, celebrating those in the industry who work tirelessly behind the scenes and often do not receive the recognition they deserve.

The **Official Selection** of short films will be announced soon, showcasing a carefully curated lineup that promises to engage and inspire audiences with unique and thought-provoking perspectives.

Hosted at the **VUE Cinema Piccadilly**, attendees can expect two days filled with screenings, discussions, networking opportunities, and an awards ceremony honouring outstanding contributions to the world of filmmaking.
